Biography

Jonathan Katz

Deputy Assistant Administrator, Bureau for Europe and Eurasia

Jonathan Katz was appointed Deputy Assistant Administrator for the United States Agency for International Development's Bureau for Europe and Eurasia in March 2014. Previously he served as a Senior Advisor to the Assistant Secretary in the U.S. Department of State's Bureau of International Organization Affairs, from February 2010-December 2013. In that role, Katz served as a speech writer and advised the Assistant Secretary and other senior officials on key U.S. national security and multilateral policies and priorities at the United Nations and other international organizations.

Prior to the State Department, Katz worked in the U.S. House of Representatives for thirteen years, serving as the Staff Director and Minority Staff Director of the Europe Subcommittee on the House Committee on Foreign Affairs, and as Legislative Director and Senior Foreign Policy Advisor for Congressman Robert Wexler. In those roles, Katz advised the Congressman on foreign policy, development, defense and trade. In 1994 and 1996, Katz served in senior positions on Congressional campaigns in Florida. He received his B.A. from Syracuse University.
