

Philippe Le Corre is a Non-resident Senior Fellow with the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace and a Senior Fellow at the Harvard Kennedy School's Mossavar-Rahmani Center for Business and Government. Mr. Le Corre was previously a Fellow at The Brookings Institution. He served as a Special Assistant for international affairs to the French defense minister from 2004-2007, and as a Senior Policy Adviser on Asia in the Ministry's policy planning staff.

Mr. Le Corre has been specializing in EU-China relations, outbound Chinese direct investments and great powers competition. He is currently heading a project that looks at perceptions in Europe and Central Asia of China's global rise, with a comparative angle. He has contributed to numerous publications, including *The Wall Street Journal*, *The National Interest*, *Nikkei Asian Review* and *Foreign Affairs*. His last book is *China's Offensive in Europe* (Brookings Institution Press, 2016).
