

## **5/15/2013 Subcommittee on Africa, Global Health, and Human Rights Markup Summary**

The Chair called up the following measures for consideration by the Committee. By unanimous consent, the three measures and two amendments (previously provided to Members of the Committee) were considered *en bloc*:

1. H.R. 1951 (Smith, NJ), “To ensure compliance with the 1980 Hague Convention on the Civil Aspects of International Child Abduction by countries with which the United States enjoys reciprocal obligations, to establish procedures for the prompt return of children abducted to other countries, and for other purposes.”
  - a. As amended by Meadows 4
2. H.R. 1897 (Smith, NJ), “To promote freedom and democracy in Vietnam.”
3. H.Res. 131 (Bass), “Concerning the ongoing conflict in the Democratic Republic of the Congo and the need for international efforts toward long-term peace, stability, and observance of human rights.”
  - a. As amended by Bass 11 (an amendment in the nature of a substitute)

The measures and respective amendments were adopted by voice vote, and favorably reported to the Full Committee, as amended, by unanimous consent.
