

Lisa Bos is the Senior Policy Advisor for Health, Education, and WASH (water, sanitation and hygiene) at World Vision in the Advocacy and Government Relations Department. As such, she serves as the point person for World Vision's advocacy and education efforts with Congress and the Administration, in addition to working to engage World Vision's advocates on issues such as foreign assistance funding, maternal and child health and WASH. Lisa also consults with international colleagues on global health and development initiatives and country advocacy efforts through World Vision's global campaign, Child Health Now.

Lisa spent nearly 9 years as a legislative staff person in the U.S. House of Representatives, including 3 years as Policy Director for the Republican Study Committee, a caucus of more than 140 Members. In this role, Lisa analyzed legislation and worked closely with committees and House Leadership on issues such as education and health care. Lisa also spent time working for Congressman Bill Huizenga of Michigan as the Senior Legislative Assistant responsible for defense, foreign affairs, education and health care issues.

Lisa has worked in the private sector as well, serving as a Vice President at Cassidy & Associates, one of Washington's leading government affairs firms, and at Russ Reid. In both of these positions, she represented the interests of education, health care, and social service institutions before Congress and federal agencies.
