

Scott Campbell is Catholic Relief Services' Regional Director for Central Africa. He coordinates CRS programs in Burundi, Cameroon, Chad, Central African Republic (CAR), the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC), the Republic of Congo (Brazzaville), and Rwanda.

Mr. Campbell is a veteran of international relief efforts, having worked in Madagascar and Haiti before joining CRS in 1999. Since coming to the agency, Mr. Campbell has coordinated food aid during the Kosovo crisis, overseen the emergency response in the 2004 tsunami in the northern Indonesian province of Aceh, and directed CRS' response to the 2010 earthquake in Haiti. He has served as CRS Country Representative in Angola, Haiti, and the Philippines.

Mr. Campbell attended the University of Massachusetts at Amherst and graduated with a bachelor's degree in international relations and political science. He has a master's degree in Nonprofit Leadership and Management from the University of San Diego.
