Madeline Rose is a Policy & Advocacy Advisor for Mercy Corps, a global humanitarian agency helping communities in the world's toughest places survive the crises they confront and turn them into opportunities they deserve. Madeline leads Mercy Corps' policy and advocacy portfolios on Sub-Saharan Africa programs, youth, development in fragile states, counterterrorism and humanitarian access, countering violent extremism and atrocity prevention. Prior to joining Mercy Corps, Madeline worked at the Friends Committee on National Legislation, where she managed the Peaceful Prevention of Deadly Conflict program and coordinated the Prevention and Protection Working Group – a coalition of NGOs working to improve U.S. government policies and civilian capacities to prevent violent conflict, mass atrocities, and protect civilians threatened by such crises. She has worked in Congress, at the United Nations, with community-based organizations in Zimbabwe and South Africa, and for the Silicon Valley tech company, NetApp.
