6/18/2014 Subcommittee on Africa, Global Health, and Human Rights Markup Summary

The Chair called up the following measures for consideration by the subcommittee. By unanimous consent, the three measures and three amendments (previously provided to Members of the Committee) were considered *en bloc*:

- 1. <u>H.R. 4653 (Wolf, VA)</u>, "To reauthorize the United States Commission on International Religious Freedom, and for other purposes."
 - a. As amended by <u>Smith 55</u> (an amendment in the nature of a substitute)
- 2. <u>H. Res. 588 (Peterson)</u>, "Concerning the suspension of exit permit issuance by the Government of the Democratic Republic of Congo for adopted Congolese children seeking to depart the country with their adoptive parents."
 - a. As amended by <u>Smith 56</u>
- 3. <u>H. Res. 503 (Smith, NJ)</u>, "Expressing the sense of the House of Representatives regarding the need to bring the South Sudan conflict to a sustainable and lasting end and to promote reconciliation of longstanding and recent grievances to allow for a peaceful society with good governance."
 - a. As amended by <u>Smith 54</u>

The measures and respective amendments were adopted by voice vote, and favorably reported to the full committee, as amended, by unanimous consent.
