For #5: NED receives funds primarily from the US Government and recently from several foreign governments (Sweden and Canada) to carry out democracy promotion activities in 90+ countries globally. NED grants funds to local organizations, and also carries out democracy initiatives directly through our work under the World Movement for Democracy. Funds are awarded from the USG under the NED Act on an annual basis through the Annual Appropriations process, as well as through adhoc special grants for target countries received from the Department of State (DOS).

Since January 1, 2013, there were no special grants awarded from DOS related to the subject of this hearing, however, general appropriations were made to NED by Congress as follows:


- Annual Appropriation FY 2014 (10/1/13 - 9/30/18) for \$135,000,000; and
- Annual Appropriation FY 2015 (10/1/14 - 9/30/19) for \$135,000,000.

Amounts awarded which were utilized in part since January 1, 2013 by foreign governments are as follows:

- Swedish International Development Agency (SIDA) passed through the International Center for Not-for-Profit Law (ICNL) for the project period 7/1/12 - 6/30/15 for \$2,911,167; and
- Canadian Dept. of Foreign Affairs Trade & Development (formerly Dept of Foreign Affairs & International Trade, or DFAIT) for the project period 12/1/08-3/31/2013 for 1,079,164 CAD.
