

Devon M. Davenport is a Research Scientist from a biopharmaceutical company in Research Triangle Park, North Carolina. But, most importantly, he is the left-behind father of Nadia Lynn, who was abducted to Brazil by her mother in February of 2009.

He filed a Hague return application immediately, which he won, and which has withstood appeals in court after court since—but 6 years later, Nadia is still in Brazil.

March 4 2015, the Special Appeal at the Superior Court was finally rejected, however, the taking parent continues to use delay tactics, in order to prevent the inevitable order of return for Nadia back to the United States by filing yet another appeal before the Superior Court.
