Bindu Philips is the mother of twin boys, Albert and Alfred, who are United States citizens and were born in New Jersey in 2000. Albert and Alfred lived in New Jersey prior to their abduction to India, by their father, who had deceptively premeditated the abduction and took the family to India on the pretext of a family vacation. In spite of Ms. Philips being granted custody of the children in the United States by the Superior Court of New Jersey in 2009, she is unable to see or communicate with her children.

Bindu Philips has been seeking justice in United States and India to be reunited with her precious children for the last 6 years.
