Mizra Ismail, is Chairman of the Yezidi Human Rights Organization International in Ontario, Canada, which he founded in 2009 to protect the rights of Yezidi people worldwide. This organization has worked with the Government of Canada to attain refugee status for Iraqi Yezidis there. Prior to founding that organization, he was Chairman and Co-Founder of London Yezidis Community-Canada. He has written and given interviews extensively on the plight of Yezidis in Iraq. Mr. Ismail is from Sinjar, Nineveh Province, Iraq, but now lives in the United States.
