Dr. Nguyen Dinh Thang came to the US as a boat refugee in 1979. He obtained a PhD in Mechanical Engineering from Virginia Tech and served as a research engineer with the US Navy. He joined Boat People SOS as a volunteer in 1988 and devoted the past 25 years defending the rights of refugees and combating human trafficking. In 2008 he co-founded Coalition to Abolish Modern-day Slavery in Asia (CAMSA), which has rescued or assisted over 4,000 victims of labor and sex trafficking.
