Fonteh Akum is Executive Director at the Institute for Security Studies (ISS). He previously headed the ISS Lake Chad Basin program, based in Dakar, Senegal.

Prior to joining the ISS in 2017, Fonteh worked for the Council for the Development of Social Science Research in Africa, the Africa Program of the United Nations University for Peace and at the International Monetary Fund.

Dr. Fonteh has researched and published on violence, governance, and human security in transitional contexts. He has also conducted field-based research in 12 African countries spanning all regions of Africa. Dr. Fonteh holds an MA from the American University’s School of International Service in Washington, DC and a PhD in Politics and International Studies from the University of London’s School of Oriental and African Studies.
