



Mr. Rajiv S. Maan began his career in law enforcement in 1994 as a Police Officer at the Yuba City Police, Yuba City, CA. In 1999, Mr. Maan joined the California Department of Justice, Bureau of Narcotic Enforcement and worked as a Special Agent in the greater Los Angeles area on a major methamphetamine investigation team.

In October 2002, Mr. Maan entered the FBI as a Special Agent. He was first assigned to the Los Angeles Field Office where he worked State Sponsored Counterterrorism matters. In July 2008, he was promoted as a Supervisory Special Agent to the FBI Headquarters, Counterterrorism Division, International Terrorism Operation Section I, where he served as a program manager for the southeast region offices. In March 2011, Mr. Maan was promoted to Legal Attaché at the US Embassy in Amman, Jordan.

In November 2013, Mr. Maan returned to FBI Headquarters as a Unit Chief in the Counterintelligence Division, Global Section. In August 2015, Mr. Maan was promoted to Supervisory Special Agent of a Global Counterintelligence Squad at the Los Angeles Field Office. In September 2021, Mr. Maan was promoted to an Assistant Special Agent in Charge at the Los Angeles Field Office working Counterterrorism matters.

Finally, in July 2023, Mr. Maan was promoted as Director of the High-Value Detainee Interrogation Group. In September 2023, he was reassigned to the Hostage Recovery Fusion Cell and shortly thereafter, was selected as the Director of HRFC.
