

<p>1. As a Georgetown professor, I received a grant of around \$12,000 from CREATE, which is funded by the Department of Homeland Security. This grant is no longer active. Other parts of Georgetown have received Title VI National Resource Center grants, but to my knowledge they are not linked to my position.</p> <p>2. I am an Intelligence Community associate and have been for many years. This involves both occasional consulting with intelligence agencies and at times doing additional longer-term research. The amount varies each year: in 2013 I expect this figure to be less than \$20,000 based on current projects.</p> <p>3. I do occasional work as a consultant for the RAND Corporation, which is federally funded.</p> <p>4. I am often a guest speaker or participant in work for various U.S. government contractors such as CENTRA.</p> <p>5. The Brookings Institution will at times host a U.S. government-funded conference, such as one by CENTCOM, which will occur in September of this year. My work as part of that conference is supported by government money, but that is a small fraction of my time at Brookings.</p>
