

The Washington Institute had an Intergovernmental Personnel Act (IPA) Agreement with the Department of State enabling David Makovsky (myself) to work in the Department of State's Office of the Special Envoy for Israeli-Palestinian Negotiations. The original agreement was 11/7/2013 to 11/16/2014, but ended up running until September 4, 2014. The original agreement was for \$288,000 in contract fees, but total contract revenue received by the Institute ended being \$230,856 due to the shortening of the length of the agreement
