

Anthony H. Cordesman: Biography

Anthony H. Cordesman holds the Arleigh A. Burke Chair in Strategy at CSIS. During his time at CSIS, he has completed a wide variety of studies on U.S. strategy and defense plans, net assessments of regional balances and forces, the lessons of modern war, defense programming and budgeting, NATO modernization, Chinese and Korean military power, the lessons of modern warfare, proliferation, and counterterrorism.

He previously served in the Office of the Secretary of Defense, the State Department, NATO International Staff, and Department of Energy, and Adjunct Professor of National Security at Georgetown University; and was seconded to the National Security Council. He is a recipient of the Department of Defense Distinguished Service Medal. He also served as National Security Assistant to Senator John McCain. He is currently a Senior Advisor to US Asia.
