

Dr. Sameer Lalwani is an External Senior Advisor with the Special Competitive Studies Project, a Non-Resident Senior Fellow with the German Marshall Fund, and a Research Affiliate with the MIT Security Studies Program, where he studies military and technology competition, alliances, and Indo-Pacific security. He is also a Contributing Editor to *War on the Rocks*. Previously, he was a Senior Expert at the US Institute of Peace where led work sponsored by the U.S. Department of Defense on the China-India battlespace and supporting US-India defense technology cooperation, including INDUS-X. He has previously been the Director of the South Asia Program at the Stimson Center, an Adjunct Professor at GWU's Elliott School of International Affairs, a term member with the Council on Foreign Relations, and a Stanton Nuclear Security Postdoctoral Fellow at the RAND Corporation.
