Edmund F. Haislmaier has twenty years experience as an analyst of health care public policies and markets. He is currently Research Fellow with the Center for Health Policy Studies at The Heritage Foundation.

Haislmaier's previous experience includes five years as a health policy and management consultant, four years as Director, Health Care Policy in the Corporate Strategic Planning and Policy division of Pfizer, Inc., and seven years as the Senior Policy Analyst for health care issues at The Heritage Foundation.
