Kevin C. Brady currently serves as the deputy chief of staff for the Texas Department of Insurance (TDI). TDI is charged with regulating the Texas insurance market, protecting the interests of consumers, and fostering fair competition within the insurance industry.

Mr. Brady's wide-ranging responsibilities include the areas of regulatory policy, operational administration, and strategic management. He serves as an advisor to the Texas Commissioner of Insurance and facilitates the implementation of executive-level decisions, including TDI's priorities, business planning and management. He also coordinates the development of TDI's recommendations to the Texas Legislature on legislative changes relating to the regulation of insurance.

Mr. Brady began his career at TDI in 1984 as a financial examiner conducting solvency examinations of insurers. He has held a variety of positions, primarily related to the financial regulation of insurers, from initial company formation through receivership. He previously served as TDI's associate commissioner for Licensing and Registration, supervising the licensing of all insurance companies and agents in Texas.
