3 **SECTION 1. LANCE CORPORAL DANIEL NATHAN DEYARMIN**
4 **POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

5 (a) REDESIGNATION.—The facility of the United
6 States Postal Service located at 162 Northeast Avenue in
7 Tallmadge, Ohio, shall be known and designated as the

1 “Lance Corporal Daniel Nathan Deyarmin Post Office
2 Building”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the “Lance Corporal Daniel
7 Nathan Deyarmin Post Office Building”.
