## SEC. 6. RELATIONSHIP TO THE FREEDOM OF INFORMA-2 TION ACT. 3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Nothing in this Act shall be construed to— 4 5 (1) require the disclosure of information or 6 records that are exempt from public disclosure under 7 section 552 of title 5, United States Code; or 8 (2) to impose any affirmative duty on the Di-9 rector to review congressionally mandated reports 10 submitted for publication to the reports website for

1	the purpose of identifying and redacting such infor-
2	mation or records.
3	(b) WITHHOLDING AND REDACTION OF INFORMA-
4	TION.—The head of a Federal agency may withhold infor-
5	mation required to be disclosed under this Act if the infor-
6	mation would be properly withheld from disclosure under
7	section 552 of title 5, United States Code, and shall—
8	(1) redact information required to be disclosed
9	under this Act if disclosure of such information is
10	prohibited by law;
11	(2) redact information being withheld under
12	this subsection prior to submitting the information
13	to the Director;
14	(3) redact only such information properly with-
15	held under this subsection from the submission of
16	information or from any congressionally mandated
17	report submitted under this Act;
18	(4) identify where any such redaction is made
19	in the submission or report; and
20	(5) identify the exemption under which each
21	such redaction is made.

Page 11, line 21, strike "section 4(c)" and insert "section 4(b)".

Amend the title so as to read: "A bill to require the Director of the Government Publishing Office to establish and maintain an online portal accessible to the public

that allows the public to obtain electronic copies of all congressionally mandated reports in one place, and for other purposes.".
