A BILL

To amend the Virgin Islands of the United States Centennial Commission Act to extend the expiration date of the Commission, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.**

4 The Virgin Islands of the United States Centennial
5 Commission Act (Public Law 114–224) is amended—

6 (1) in section 4, by adding at the end the fol-
7 lowing new subsection:

8 “(i) **FAILURE TO APPOINT.**—If the Governor of the
9 Virgin Islands of the United States or the designee of the
10 Governor declines to make or does not make the appoint-

1 ment of a member by the deadline described under sub-
2 section (e), that member shall be appointed by the Dele-
3 gate to the House of Representatives from the United
4 States Virgin Islands.”;

5 (2) in section 7(b), by striking “January 31,
6 2018” and inserting “January 31, 2019”;

7 (3) in section 10, by striking “September 30,
8 2018” and inserting “September 30, 2019”; and

9 (4) by striking section 11.
