Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 SEC. 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 2 This Act may be cited as the "COVID Preparedness,
- 3 Response, and Effective Planning for Advanced Require-
- 4 ments by the Executive Branch Act of 2020" or the
- 5 "COVID PREPARE Act of 2020".

6 SEC. 2. COVID-19 RESURGENCE PLAN.

- 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 30 days after the
- 8 date of the enactment of this Act, the head of each agency
- 9 shall submit to Congress an initial report detailing an ac-
- 10 tion plan, informed by research and best practices learned
- 11 from the onset of COVID-19 and previous presidentially
- 12 declared emergencies, for addressing the needs and miti-
- 13 gating and eliminating the risks and challenges associated
- 14 with any resurgence in COVID-19 cases, that includes—
- 15 (1) agency priorities for preparing for and re-
- sponding to any resurgence of COVID-19, including

1	continuity of operations and fulfilling the mission of
2	the agency;
3	(2) measurable goals specific to priorities and a
4	time line for addressing each priority;
5	(3) anticipated challenges to addressing prior-
6	ities and how the agency will address such chal-
7	lenges;
8	(4) how the agency will consult with Congress,
9	the public, State and municipal governments, and
10	relevant stakeholders while working remotely; and
11	(5) how the agency plans to issue relevant guid-
12	ance to entities under the jurisdiction of the agency.
13	(b) Subsequent Reports.—Not later than 60 days
14	after the date of the enactment of this Act, and quarterly
15	thereafter until the President ends the declared emer-
16	gency, the head of each agency shall submit to Congress
17	a report that provides an update of the details submitted
18	in the plan under subsection (a), including—
19	(1) the status of each priority;
20	(2) an explanation for any goal that has not
21	been met within the specified time frame; and
22	(3) any changes or updates to the plan.
23	(c) Definitions.—In this section:

1	(1) AGENCY.—The term "agency" has the
2	meaning given that term in section 551 of title 5,
3	United States Code.
4	(2) STATE.—The term "State" means each of
5	the several States, the District of Columbia, each
6	commonwealth, territory, or possession of the United
7	States, and each federally recognized Indian Tribe.
