AMENDMENT TO H.R.

OFFERED BY MR. LYNCH OF MASSACHUSETTS

At the end of the bill, add the following:

SEC. 4. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATION FOR UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE FOR MODERNIZA TION OF POSTAL INFRASTRUCTURE.

4 There is authorized to be appropriated to the United 5 States Postal Service \$8,000,000,000, to remain available 6 until expended, for the acquisition of vehicles and the in-7 frastructure required to operate a fleet of electric vehicles. 8 Any amounts appropriated under this subsection shall be 9 deposited into the Postal Service Fund established under 10 section 2003 of title 39, United States Code.

11SEC. 5. ELECTRIC OR ZERO-EMISSION VEHICLES FOR12UNITED STATES POSTAL SERVICE FLEET.

13 (a) IN GENERAL.—Any next generation delivery vehicle purchased by the United States Postal Service using 14 15 the funds appropriated under section 4 shall, to the greatest extent practicable, be an electric or zero-emission vehi-16 17 cle, and the Postal Service shall ensure that at least 75 18 percent of the total number of vehicles purchased using such funds shall be electric or zero emission vehicles. In 19 this subsection, the term "next generation delivery vehi-20

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cle" means a vehicle purchased to replace a right-hand
 drive, long-life vehicle in use by the Postal Service.

- 3 (b) Medium and Heavy-duty Vehicles.—
- 4 (1) DATE OF ENACTMENT AND 2025.—Between 5 the period beginning on the date of enactment of 6 this Act and ending on December 31, 2024, not less 7 than 75 percent of the total number of new medium 8 or heavy-duty vehicles purchased by the Postal Serv-9 ice during such period shall be electric or zero-emis-10 sion vehicles.

(2) AFTER 2029.—Beginning on January 1,
2030, the Postal Service may not purchase any new
medium or heavy-duty vehicle that is not an electric
or zero-emission vehicle.

(c) COMPLIANCE.—The Postal Service shall comply
with chapter 83 of title 41, United States Code, (popularly
known as the Buy American Act) and any applicable Federal labor or civil rights laws—

(1) in carrying out subsections (a) and (b); and
(2) with respect to any vehicle purchased using
funds appropriated under section 4.

22 (d) CHARGING STATIONS.—

(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than January 1,
2026, the Postal Service shall provide, at each postal
facility accessible to the public, not less than 1 elec-

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tric vehicle charging station for use by the public or
 officers and employees of the Postal Service.

3 (2) FLEET OPERATION.—The Postal Service
4 shall ensure that adequate charging stations are
5 available at Postal Service facilities to keep the
6 Postal Service fleet operational.

7 (e) PLAN AND UPDATE.—Not later than 180 days 8 after the date of enactment of this Act, the Postmaster 9 General shall submit to the Committee on Oversight and 10 Reform of the House of Representatives, the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs of the 11 12 Senate, and the Committees on Appropriations of the 13 House of Representatives and the Senate a plan to carry out this section. The Postmaster General shall submit an 14 15 update and progress report on implementing such plan to such committees not less than once every two years begin-16 17 ning on the date the plan is submitted under the previous 18 sentence and ending on the day that is six years after such 19 date.

(f) CONTINGENT ON APPROPRIATION.—The requirements of subsections (a) through (e) of this section shall
not apply unless the funds authorized under section 4 are
appropriated.

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
