Since joining the DoD Office of Inspector General (OIG) in 2004, Ms. Hull has held a variety of staff and leadership positions, such as auditor, team leader, project manager, program director, Deputy Assistant Inspector General. In those roles, Ms. Hull conducted multiple audits in the areas of major defense contractor pension plans, weapons systems spare parts pricing, contract management, and contract payments.



In January 2018, Ms. Hull became a member of the Senior Executive Service as the Assistant Inspector General (AIG) for the DoD OIG's Acquisition, Contracting, and Sustainment (ACS) Directorate. The ACS Directorate conducts audits of major weapon system acquisitions, contracts, sustainment management, health care, and congressional interest audits. As the AIG, Ms. Hull oversaw two audits involving TransDigm, and testified before the House Committee on Oversight and Reform in May 2019 regarding Report No. DODIG-2019-060, "Review of Parts Purchased From TransDigm, Inc.," February 25, 2019.

In 2021, she was selected to serve as the DoD OIG's Deputy Inspector General for Diversity and Inclusion and Extremism in the Military.

Ms. Hull has also worked at other agencies in the Federal IG community, including the Department of Justice OIG and the National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency OIG. She graduated from Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University in 2004 with a Bachelor of Science in Accounting and Information Systems and a Bachelor of Arts in English, with a Professional Writing concentration. Ms. Hull also has a Certificate of Project Management from George Washington University and is a Certified Fraud Examiner.
