Amendment in the Nature of a Substitute to H.R. 7686 Offered by Mrs. Carolyn B. Maloney of New York

Strike all that follows after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "District of Columbia3 Code Returning Citizens Coordination Act".

4 SEC. 2. PROVISION OF INFORMATION TO THE DISTRICT OF
5 COLUMBIA RELATED TO CERTAIN PERSONS
6 UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE BUREAU
7 OF PRISONS.

8 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Di-9 rector of the Bureau of Prisons shall provide to the Mayor 10 of the District of Columbia for each person under the ju-11 risdiction of the Bureau of Prisons pursuant to the Na-12 tional Capital Revitalization and Self-Government Im-13 provement Act of 1997 (Public Law 105–33), the fol-14 lowing:

- 15 (1) Every 90 days, the following information:
- 16 (A) The name, age, and Federal Register17 Number of the person.

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1 (B) The facility where the person is 2 housed.

- 3 (C) The scheduled release date.
- 4 (2) Upon the request of the Mayor, the infor5 mation that the Director provides for such person to
 6 the Director of the Court Services and Offender Su7 pervision Agency for the District of Columbia.

8 SEC. 3. PROHIBITION ON DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA DISCLO9 SURE.

10 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the 11 Mayor of the District of Columbia may not disclose the 12 information provided pursuant to this Act outside of the District of Columbia government, except that the Mayor— 13 14 (1) may not provide such information to any 15 District of Columbia law enforcement agency; and 16 (2) may provide the information provided under 17 paragraph (1) of section 2 to counsel for the per-18 sons, and to organizations that provide legal rep-19 resentation to persons in criminal or post-conviction

20 matters, or in matters related to reentry.

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
