A BILL

To amend title 28, United States Code, to allow for twelve associate justices of the Supreme Court of the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Judiciary Act of
5 2021”.

6 **SEC. 2. NUMBER OF JUSTICES; QUORUM.**

7 Section 1 of title 28, United States Code, is amended
8 by striking “a Chief Justice of the United States and eight
9 associate justices, any six of whom shall constitute a
10 quorum” and inserting “a Chief Justice of the United
