Re: Hearing on "Federal Pandemic Spending: A Prescription for Waste, Fraud and Abuse"

On Wednesday, February 1, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. E.T., in room 2154 of the Rayburn House Office Building, the Full Committee on Oversight and Accountability will host a hearing on "Federal Pandemic Spending: A Prescription for Waste, Fraud and Abuse."

#### I. BACKGROUND:

Numerous reports by federal watchdogs and the media have found evidence of massive levels of waste, fraud, and abuse in Federal COVID-relief programs. Reports have estimated that as much as \$560 billion in Federal COVID-relief funding may have been improperly paid out or lost.

#### II. HEARING PURPOSE:

The hearing will examine government efforts to investigate waste, fraud, abuse, and mismanagement in COVID-relief programs and determine what policies should be implemented to ensure federal funds go to their intended recipients.
