Re: "Protecting Speech from Government Interference and Social Media Bias, Part 1: Twitter's Role in Suppressing the Biden Laptop Story"

On Wednesday, February 8, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. E.T., in room 2154 of the Rayburn House Office Building, the Full Committee on Oversight and Accountability will host a hearing on "The Twitter Files."

I. BACKGROUND:

In October 2020—only a few weeks before the presidential election—Twitter suppressed a story published by the *New York Post* that reported on Hunter Biden's abandoned laptop that raised issues about then-former Vice President Biden.

The hearing will examine the role former Twitter executives played in suppressing the Biden laptop story.
