Re: Hearing on “Oversight of Our Nation’s Largest Employer: Reviewing the U.S. Office of Personnel Management”

I. BACKGROUND:

The U.S. Office of Personnel Management (OPM) is responsible for a civilian workforce of approximately 2.1 million employees, management of federal benefits, and the operational policies and personnel guidance for all agencies. OPM is establishing the new Postal Service Health Benefits (PSHB) Program established through the *Postal Service Reform Act of 2022*.

This hearing will examine OPM’s management of the federal workforce and its ability to deliver on its mission of serving American taxpayers.
