Re: Hearing titled “Death by a Thousand Regulations: The Biden Administration’s Campaign to Bury America in Red Tape”

On Wednesday, June 14, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. ET in 2154 Rayburn House Office Building, the Full Committee on Oversight and Accountability will host a hearing titled “Death by a Thousand Regulations: The Biden Administration’s Campaign to Bury America in Red Tape.”

I. BACKGROUND:

Since assuming office on January 20, 2021, the Biden Administration has pursued a “whole-of-government” regulatory blowout. This has resulted in skyrocketing regulatory costs. First-year regulatory costs under the Biden Administration, for example, well exceed even the levels reached under the Obama Administration.

II. HEARING PURPOSE:

This hearing will examine the Biden Administration’s historically high level of government overreach through the regulatory process.
