3 **SECTION 1. SECOND LIEUTENANT PATRICK PALMER CAL-**
4 **HOUN POST OFFICE.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 120 West Church Street in

1 Mount Vernon, Georgia, shall be known and designated
2 as the “Second Lieutenant Patrick Palmer Calhoun Post
3 Office”.

4 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
5 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
6 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
7 be deemed to be a reference to the “Second Lieutenant
8 Patrick Palmer Calhoun Post Office”.
