I. BACKGROUND:

House Rules require each standing committee (with the exception of the Committee on Ethics) to hold a Member Day hearing during the first session of the 118th Congress to hear testimony from all Members of Congress, Delegates, and the Resident Commissioner on proposed legislation within the Committee's jurisdiction.

II. HEARING PURPOSE:

This hearing will provide all Members, regardless of Committee assignment, the opportunity to testify on specific Committee-referred legislation, issues within the Committee's jurisdiction, or topics of importance to them, their district, and their constituents. Members will be grouped into panels of four, based on their availability, and will be recognized for five minutes to testify on proposed legislation and other priorities that fall within the Committee's jurisdiction. Committee staff will be in contact with Member offices to discuss time slots for each panel in advance of the hearing.
