Dear Chairman Comer:

Thank you for your March 18, 2024, letter requesting that Mr. Jason Galanis, Hunter Biden's business associate, be permitted to testify remotely.<sup>1</sup> You explained that Mr. Galanis is unable to attend in-person because he is in federal custody.<sup>2</sup> As you state in your letter, he is uniquely situated to testify about the Biden family's influence peddling schemes and his testimony is critical to both the impeachment inquiry and to further the Committee's legislative purposes.<sup>3</sup>

Pursuant to the House Rules for the 118<sup>th</sup> Congress and the Regulations for the Remote Participation of Committee Witnesses, I hereby grant your request for Mr. Jason Galanis to testify remotely.<sup>4</sup> Please ensure that this letter along with your March 18, 2024, request letter are made part of the hearing record at the appropriate time.
