

**AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE
TO H.R. 7524
OFFERED BY MR. COMER OF KENTUCKY**

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the “GSA Technology Ac-
3 countability Act”.

**4 SEC. 2. TRANSPARENCY OF GSA FUNDED INFORMATION
5 TECHNOLOGY SERVICES.**

6 (a) TRANSPARENCY ON USE OF THE FEDERAL CIT-
7 IZEN SERVICES FUND.—Section 323 of title 40, United
8 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
9 lowing:

10 “(g) REQUIREMENT FOR ANNUAL REPORT TO CON-
11 GRESS.—Not later than September 30 of each year, the
12 Administrator shall submit to the Committee on Oversight
13 and Accountability of the House of Representatives and
14 the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental
15 Affairs of the Senate a report that includes, at a min-
16 imum, a list of each program funded by expenditures dur-
17 ing the previous fiscal year, or that have been funded by

1 expenditures in the previous 5-year period, including the
2 following:

3 “(1) An explanation of the program.

4 “(2) Information about how the program is
5 funded, including the amount of expenditures the
6 program received in the previous fiscal year and
7 total amount.

8 “(3) The amount of reimbursements associated
9 with or anticipated to be associated with the pro-
10 gram from another source of funds or another agen-
11 cy, if applicable.

12 “(4) A description of projects or initiatives as-
13 sociated with the program, including—

14 “(A) information about when the projects
15 or initiatives were initiated and completed; and

16 “(B) funding information, to the extent
17 practicable.

18 “(5) Any additional information, data, or anal-
19 ysis used to determine the information estimated
20 within the report, if applicable.

21 “(h) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

22 “(1) ADMINISTRATOR.—The term ‘Adminis-
23 trator’ means the Administrator of General Services.

24 “(2) EXPENDITURE.—The term ‘expenditure’
25 means any obligation of funds from the Fund.”.

1 (b) TRANSPARENCY ON USE OF THE ACQUISITION
2 SERVICES FUND.—Section 321 of title 40, United States
3 Code, is amended by adding at the end the following:

4 “(h) REQUIREMENT FOR ANNUAL REPORT TO CON-
5 GRESS.—Not later than September 30 of each year, the
6 Administrator shall submit to the Committee on Oversight
7 and Accountability of the House of Representatives and
8 the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental
9 Affairs of the Senate a report that includes, at a min-
10 imum, a list of each program within the Technology
11 Transformation Services funded by expenditures during
12 the previous fiscal year, or that have been funded by ex-
13 penditures in the previous 5-year period, including the fol-
14 lowing:

15 “(1) An explanation of the program.

16 “(2) Information about how the program is
17 funded, including the amount of expenditures the
18 program received in the previous fiscal year and
19 total amount.

20 “(3) The amount of reimbursements associated
21 with or anticipated to be associated with the pro-
22 gram from another source of funds or another agen-
23 cy, if applicable.

24 “(4) A description of projects or initiatives as-
25 sociated with the program, including—

1 “(A) information about when the projects
2 or initiatives were initiated and completed; and

3 “(B) funding information, to the extent
4 practicable.

5 “(5) Any additional information, data, or anal-
6 ysis used to determine the information estimated
7 within the report, if applicable.

8 “(i) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

9 “(1) ADMINISTRATOR.—The term ‘Adminis-
10 trator’ means the Administrator of General Services.

11 “(2) EXPENDITURE.—The term ‘expenditure’
12 means any obligation of funds from the Acquisition
13 Services Fund for programs referenced in subsection
14 (h).”.

15 “(c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
16 this Act shall take effect on the commencement of the first
17 fiscal year after the date of the enactment of this Act.
