Re: Hearing titled "Oversight of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency"

On Wednesday, July 10, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. ET in 2154 Rayburn House Office Building, the Full Committee on Oversight and Accountability will hold a hearing titled "Oversight of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency."

I. BACKGROUND:

Throughout the 118th Congress, the Committee on Oversight and Accountability has explored the impacts of excessive regulation, including environmental regulation, on U.S. consumers, small businesses, and industries.
