Re: Hearing titled “Oversight of the U.S. Postal Service”

On Tuesday, December 10, 2024, at 10:00 AM ET in room HVC-210 of the U.S. Capitol Visitor Center, the Full Committee on Oversight and Accountability will host a hearing titled “Oversight of the U.S. Postal Service.”

I. BACKGROUND:

The Committee on Oversight and Accountability has jurisdiction over the Postal Service under House Rule X(1)(n)(9). In May 2023, the Subcommittee on Government Operations and the Federal Workforce held a general oversight hearing of the Postal Service. Since that time, the Postal Service has continued to face significant financial losses and operational challenges related to implementation of the *Delivering for America* plan. The Postal Service played a significant role in the recent federal election cycle by delivering election mail to and from voters.

II. HEARING PURPOSE:

This hearing will enable the Committee to conduct oversight over all aspects of Postal Service operations and performance, to include Postmaster General DeJoy’s efforts to improve the Postal Service’s financial outlook.
