

Amendment offered by Rep. Crockett Adding a Subcommittee on Civil Rights and Civil Liberties

Rule 6(a) is amended by:

1. amending the title to read “Subcommittee on the Military, Foreign Affairs, and Federal Law Enforcement;
2. striking paragraph (F);
3. amending paragraph (E) by replacing everything after “over” with the following: “national security, foreign operations, the U.S. borders and immigration, homeland security, criminal justice, and federal law and regulatory enforcement.” and;
4. adding at the end the following new paragraph:
“(G) Subcommittee *on Civil Rights and Civil Liberties*, which has oversight jurisdiction over: issues related to civil rights, civil liberties and the equal protection of laws, including voting rights, reproductive rights, freedom of religion, speech, press, and assembly; equal employment; nondisclosure agreements; and criminal justice reform policies.
