

**AMENDMENT IN THE NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE  
TO H.R. 6330  
OFFERED BY MR. COMER OF KENTUCKY**

Strike all after the enacting clause and insert the following:

**1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Federal Relocation  
3 Payment Improvement Act of 2025”.

**4 SEC. 2. LUMP-SUM RELOCATION PAYMENTS FOR RELO-  
5 CATED FEDERAL EMPLOYEES.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 57 of  
7 title 5, United States Code, is amended by adding at the  
8 end the following:

**9 “§ 5739a. Authority for lump sum payment for relo-  
10 cation**

11 “(a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other pro-  
12 vision of this subchapter, when the head of the agency con-  
13 cerned (or a designee) authorizes or approves, an agency,  
14 through the proper disbursing official, may pay to an em-  
15 ployee who relocates in the interest of the Government,  
16 a one-time lump sum payment in lieu of any payment oth-  
17 erwise authorized or required under this subchapter.

1        “(b) REGULATIONS.—Under section 5738 of this  
2 title, the Administrator of General Services shall prescribe  
3 regulations necessary for the implementation and adminis-  
4 tration of this section, including—

5            “(1) when agencies may authorize a one-time  
6 lump sum payment under this section or the pay-  
7 ments otherwise authorized or required under this  
8 subchapter;

9            “(2) how agencies will calculate the lump sum  
10 amount; and

11            “(3) the process for employees to dispute a re-  
12 location expenses claim with their agency, notice of  
13 the employee’s right to appeal the agency decision to  
14 the Civilian Board of Contract Appeals, and citation  
15 to the Board’s procedures governing the appeals  
16 process.”.

17        (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections  
18 for such subchapter is amended by adding after the item  
19 relating to section 5739 the following:

“5739a. Authority for lump sum payment for relocation.”.
