

Bio for Minnesota State Representative Walter Hudson

Walter Hudson serves his second term in the Minnesota House of Representatives, elected among his caucus as an assistant caucus leader, and assigned the following committees:

- Fraud Prevention and State Agency Accountability
- Education Finance
- Public Safety Finance and Policy
- Judiciary Finance and Policy

Hudson previously served as a city council member in Albertville, Minnesota, where he lives with his wife and two sons.

He produces a political commentary podcast, 'Closing Argument,' branded after a weeknight evening news talk radio program he hosted from 2017 to 2020 on Twin Cities News Talk AM 1130 in Minneapolis. Hudson is a contributor to HotAir, previously contributed to PJ Media, and once served as an associate editor for the David Horowitz Freedom Center.

Outside politics, Hudson's experience has been divided between logistics and risk management. He has worked as an operations manager for a delivery contractor and served several roles in commercial security – from duty officer to interim district manager.
