### **Report, H.Res. \_\_\_\_ (Comer), RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THAT THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES FIND FORMER PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES WILLIAM J. CLINTON IN CONTEMPT OF CONGRESS FOR REFUSAL TO COMPLY WITH A SUBPOENA DULY ISSUED BY THE COMMITTEE ON OVERSIGHT AND GOVERNMENT REFORM**

A Report on the Resolution, H.Res. \_\_\_\_, “recommending that the House of Representatives find former President of the United States William J. Clinton in Contempt of Congress for refusal to comply with a subpoena duly issued by the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform.”

1. Mr. Comer offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute (ANS) making certain technical edits as well as clarifying the name of the counsel representing President Clinton and adding language further describing negotiations between the Committee and President Clinton. The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.
2. Ms. Lee offered an amendment to the ANS to strike all language of the report and replace it with language to hold Attorney General Pam Bondi in contempt for the DOJ's lack of compliance with the Oversight Committee's August 5, 2025 subpoena. The amendment failed by a Roll Call vote of 19-24 (**Vote #1**).

3. Mr. Min offered an amendment to the ANS to strike the resolve clause and replaces it with language to hold William J. Clinton in civil contempt as opposed to criminal

contempt for lack of compliance with the December 15, 2025 subpoena. The amendment failed by a Roll Call vote of 19-25 (**Vote #2**).
