### H.R. 7274 (Timmons), THE “FEDERAL ACQUISITION SECURITY COUNCIL IMPROVEMENT ACT OF 2026”

A bill to amend title 41, United States Code, to make changes with respect to the Federal Acquisition Security Council, and for other purposes.

1. Mr. Comer offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute (ANS) making a minor technical edit. The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.

**The bill, H.R. 7274, as amended, was ordered favorably reported by Roll Call vote of 40-1 (Vote #1).**

### H.R. 2985 (Mace), THE “MODERNIZING GOVERNMENT TECHNOLOGY REFORM ACT”

A bill to amend section 1078 of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2018 to increase the effectiveness of the Technology Modernization Fund, and for other purposes.

1. Mr. Comer offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute (ANS) to allow the TMF Program Office to continue conducting project scoping work with agencies, ensure Congress gets prompt access to written agreements on request, and removing a requirement for the Federal CIO to compile and submit to Congress a list of agency legacy IT systems which agencies are already required to submit to Congress. The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.

2. Mr. Walkinshaw offered an amendment to the ANS to extend the maximum payback window without approval by the Director of the Office of Management and Budget from five to seven years. The amendment was withdrawn.
3. Mr. Walkinshaw offered a second amendment to the ANS to add a reporting requirement to GAO's biennial report to evaluate the extent to which TMF funds have been awarded to modernize the priority legacy IT identified by the Federal Chief Information Officer. The amendment passed by voice vote.

**H.R. 4123 (Burlison), THE “FEDERAL IMPROVEMENT IN TECHNOLOGY PROCUREMENT (FIT PROCUREMENT) ACT”**

A bill to improve Federal technology procurement, and for other purposes.

1. Mr. Comer offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute (ANS) to include additional acquisition threshold increases for the simplified procedures for purchases and property, major programs, and cost or pricing data. The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.

**H.R. 7256 (Langworthy), THE “FEDERAL WORKFORCE EARLY SEPARATION INCENTIVES ACT”**

A bill to amend section 3523 of title 5, United States Code, to increase the limit on voluntary separation incentive payments, and for other purposes.

A bill to amend title 41, United States Code, and title 10, United States Code, to provide best value through the multiple award schedule program, and for other purposes.

1. Mr. Comer offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute (ANS) to simplify the language and remove the title 10 provision which was amended in the FY26 NDAA. The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.

**H.R. 5438 (McCormick), THE “INCENTIVIZE SAVINGS ACT”**

A bill to incentivize Federal agencies to create savings for the American people, and for other purposes.

Mr. Comer offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute (ANS) to ensure that funds which would remain available for an additional fiscal year must retain their fiscal-year identity from appropriations law and authorizing the Office of Management and Budget Director to reduce retention bonus amounts for failure to execute duties. The amendment passed by voice vote.

**H.R. 5000 (Mace), THE “CYBERSECURITY HIRING MODERNIZATION ACT”**

A bill to amend title 5, United States Code, to limit the use of educational requirements or qualifications in evaluating candidates for certain cybersecurity positions in the competitive service, and for other purposes.

1. Mr. Comer offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute (ANS) to require OPM to regularly update the Federal Cyber Workforce Dashboard maintained on its website in addition to other annual publication requirements. The amendment passed by voice vote.

**The bill, H.R. 5000, as amended, was ordered favorably reported by Roll Call vote of 44-0, (Vote #8).**
