A BILL

To prohibit a congestion toll in the District of Columbia.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “DC Rejecting Oppres-
5 sive Automotive Driving Surcharges Act” or the “DC
6 ROADS Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON CONGESTION TOLL IN DISTRICT**
8 **OF COLUMBIA.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Council of the District of Co-
10 lumbia may not enact, and the Mayor of the District of

1 Columbia may not enforce, any act, resolution, or other
2 requirement which imposes a congestion toll.

3 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT TO HOME RULE
4 ACT.—Section 602(a) of the District of Columbia Home
5 Rule Act (sec. 1–206.02(a), D.C. Official Code) is amend-
6 ed—

7 (1) in paragraph (9), by striking “office; or”
8 and inserting a “office;”;

9 (2) in paragraph (10), by striking the period at
10 the end and inserting “; or”; and

11 (3) by adding at the end the following new
12 paragraph:

13 “(11) enact any act, resolution, regulation or
14 other requirement which imposes a congestion toll
15 (as such term is defined in the DC ROADS Act).”.

16 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this Act:

17 (1) CONGESTION TOLL DEFINED.—The term
18 “congestion toll” means any charge for entry into or
19 passing through a congestion tolling zone.

20 (2) CONGESTION TOLLING ZONE.—The term
21 “congestion tolling zone” means any roadways,
22 bridges, tunnels, approaches, or ramps that are lo-
23 cated within, or enter to, the geographic area of the
24 District of Columbia
