### H.R. 8096 (Burchett), THE “DUPLICATION SCORING ACT OF 2026”

A bill to require the Comptroller General of the United States to analyze certain legislation in order to prevent duplication of and overlap with existing Federal programs, offices, and initiatives.

1. Mr. Comer offered an amendment in the nature of a substitute (ANS) removing the requirement that the Government Accountability Office’s (GAO) analysis be submitted to the Congressional Budget Office and establishes a sunset that is four years after enactment. The amendment in the nature of a substitute passed by voice vote.

**The bill, H.R. 8096, as amended, was ordered favorably reported by Roll Call vote of 39-1 (Vote #1).**

**H.R. 8844 (Fitzpatrick), THE “U.S. CUSTOMS AND BORDER PROTECTION OFFICER RETIREMENT TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS ACT”**

A bill to correct the inequitable denial of enhanced retirement and annuity benefits to certain U.S. Customs and Border Protection Officers.
