Timothy S. Robbins is the acting Senior Executive Service Position of Deputy Assistant Director and Senior Official Performing the Duties of the Executive Associate Director for Enforcement and Removal Operations (ERO), U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE), Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Washington, D.C.

In this capacity, Mr. Robbins leads ERO in its mission to identify, arrest, and remove aliens who present a danger to national security or are a risk to public safety, as well as those who enter the United States illegally or otherwise undermine the integrity of our immigration laws and our border control efforts. He was appointed to the position of acting EAD in August 2019. Prior to this assignment, Mr. Robbins served as the Deputy Assistant Director for the Targeting Operations Division, Enforcement and Removal Operations.

Mr. Robbins served in the United States Army as an Aviation Crew Chief and has been employed by the United States Government for more than 27 years.

He began his law enforcement career as a Border Patrol Agent with the U.S. Immigration and Naturalization Service (INS) in 1997 in San Diego, California.

Mr. Robbins has previously held a number of key leadership positions within ICE to include: Deputy Executive Associate Director for ERO; Los Angeles Field Office Director; Los Angeles Field Intelligence Director; Deputy Chief of Staff, ICE Office of the Assistant Secretary; ERO Chief of Staff; Acting Deputy Assistant Director, Criminal Alien Division; and Acting Chief of the Secure Border Initiative.

Mr. Robbins holds a Bachelor of Science Degree in Criminal Justice and is a member of the Senior Executive Service.
