To limit the applicability of certain rules with regard to possession of a firearm or firearm attachment.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Protecting Legal Fire-

5 arms Ownership Act of 2023".

6 SEC. 2. INAPPLICABILITY OF RULE.

Any firearm or firearm attachment that was lawfully
manufactured before the effective date of a new rule or
regulation shall be grandfathered and shall be permitted

1 to be sold, transferred, and possessed in accordance with
2 the previous rule regime. The manufacturing date of a
3 firearm or firearm attachment shall be determined by the
4 serial number recorded on the firearm or firearm attach5 ment, or any other legal method of recording the date of
6 manufacturing, including packaging.
