Alex Bosco Biography

Alex Bosco, born in Milan Italy, immigrated to the United States in 1973 where his family settled in Oldwick, New Jersey. His father put himself through dental school while his mother dedicated 35 years to education, serving as a high school language teacher. The child of hard working immigrant parents, Alex was able to pursue the American dream.
