Rob Wilcox is the Federal Legal Director at Everytown for Gun Safety. He is a nationally recognized expert on gun safety policy, drawing upon more than 20 years of policy, advocacy and litigation experience. Wilcox currently leads all of Everytown for Gun Safety's federal policy work, and has been a key advisor on federal gun violence prevention legislation and executive action, including the recently enacted Bipartisan Safer Communities Act. He has testified before the U.S. House of Representatives and numerous state and local governmental bodies as a gun law expert.

Prior to joining Everytown, Wilcox worked in private practice at Cravath, Swaine, & Moore on complex litigation and regulatory matters, and he also worked at Brady Center to Prevent Gun Violence in its Legal Action Project. He graduated with honors from Northwestern University School of Law and went to college at Wesleyan University. Wilcox's gun safety work honors his 19-year-old cousin, Laura, who was shot and killed in January 2001, and the incredible live-saving progress his Aunt Amanda and Uncle Nick have made in improving California's gun safety laws.
