Re: Hearing titled "Bidenomics: A Perfect Storm of Spending, Debt, and Inflation"

On Tuesday, September 19, 2023, at 2:00 p.m. ET in room 2247 Rayburn House Office Building, the Subcommittee on Economic Growth, Energy Policy, and Regulatory Affairs will host a hearing titled "Bidenomics: A Perfect Storm of Spending, Debt, and Inflation."

### I. BACKGROUND:

Under the Biden Administration, the national debt has grown significantly, inflation rose to forty-year highs, and mortgage interest rates have skyrocketed. Out-of-control spending, debt increases, and a regulatory onslaught stifle economic growth and risk economic security.

The hearing will examine the impacts of high levels of spending, President Biden's economic policies, and will consider possible solutions to rein in federal spending, lower the national debt, decrease inflation, and balance the budget.
